All totaled, **8, 446** people received some level of services.

Over, \$133,000.00 of "in kind" equipment and medicines were left behind with local physicians to further serve the needs of the local population of Somoto,

During this ten-day mission, the doctors and staff worked 12 hour days, serving a host of thousands people that lined up outside the hospital. Patients were seen for multiple levels of medical, dental care and pharmacy service, also ranging from general medical concerns, prosthetic limbs, trauma cases, plastic and maxilla-facial and general surgeries, internal medicine as well as all levels of pediatric care.
